AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE STREET CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR FUND AND THE GENERAL FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has the opportunity to purchase rock salt for the upcoming winter season at advantageous prices, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase appropriations in the Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair (SCMR) Fund to take advantage of this opportunity,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in the Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair (SCMR) Fund, line item Other Operations by \$120,000 and in the General Fund – General Administration, line item Transfer (SCMR Fund) by \$120,000.

<u>Section 2</u>. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

<u>Section 3</u>. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

<u>Section 4</u>. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof for the reason that the supplies are necessary for the daily functioning of the Street Department, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A MODIFICATION OF CONTRACT NO. 6561 WITH PERRIN ASPHALT CO., INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance 2-2010 the City, after competitive bidding, entered into Contract No. 6561 with Perrin Asphalt Co., Inc., for the purposes of executing the 2010 Utility Patch Program; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust the unit quantities of labor and material in the contract beyond what was originally estimated, in order to meet the needs of the City in executing the 2010 utility patch program, which will increase the estimated total contract price by an amount not exceeding \$80,000.00,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a modification of Contract No. 6561 with Perrin Asphalt Co. Inc., increasing the unit quantities of labor and material as necessary in the opinion of the Director of Public Service, but not to exceed an amount \$80,000.00 over the original estimated contract price.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to pay invoices for work based upon the Contract as modified, in an amount not to exceed \$80,000.00 over the original estimated contract price, from the Water and Sewer Funds, Line Item Capital Outlay.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AND/OR CONTRACTS WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH THE CITY OF STOW, OHIO FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A WATER MAIN IN SEASONS ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the water main in Seasons Road is in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized by Ohio Revised Code §735.053 to enter into contracts with other political subdivisions, without competitive bidding, to obtain services, supplies, and materials from the other political subdivision, and

WHEREAS, the City of Stow, Ohio is willing to construct a water main for the City of Cuyahoga Falls in accordance with the City's specifications in Seasons Road from Wyoga Lake Road to the eastern corporation limits,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

 <u>Section 1.</u> The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, according to law, with the City of Stow, Ohio for replacement of a 12" water main in Seasons Road from Wyoga Lake Road to the eastern corporation limits, in accordance with the City's specifications, and to provide reimbursement for expenditures made therefor in an amount not to exceed \$42,000.00.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the Water Fund, line item Capital Outlay, in an amount not to exceed \$42,000.00.

<u>Section 3.</u> Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
