AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING CERTAIN EASEMENTS FROM PORTAGE CROSSING, LLC FOR INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRIC UTILITY FACILITIES AT THE PORTAGE CROSSING REDEVELOPMENT SITE, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE CORRESPONDING EASEMENT DOCUMENTS. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Five proposed electric facility easements to be granted by Portage Crossing, LLC to the City of Cuyahoga Falls, identified as Electric Easements "A" through "E," now on file with the Clerk of Council in Council File No. ___, together with the terms and conditions for said easements also on file with the Clerk, are hereby The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the easement documents substantially in the form now on file with the Clerk, and to cause such easements to be recorded with the Summit County Fiscal Officer.

Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. ORDINANCE NO. – 2013

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH WICHERT INSURANCE SERVICES, INC. FOR THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES NECESSARY TO MANAGE THE CITY'S RISK MANAGEMENT AND INSURANCE PROGRAM AND FOR THE PURCHASE OF PUBLIC ENTITY INSURANCE COVERAGES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with Wichert Insurance Services, Inc., on the basis of its proposal dated October 3, 2013, for the professional services necessary to manage the City's risk management and insurance program, including purchase of comprehensive public entity insurance coverages, for a period of one year.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from funds properly appropriated to the various departments of the City for these purposes, according to an apportionment of costs as between the departments.

<u>Section 3.</u> Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
