9 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC  
10 CONTROL FILE BY PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION  
11 OF VARIOUS TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, AND  
12 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.  
13

14 WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established  
15 and maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and  
16 maintained by the Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified  
17 Ordinances, and  
18

19 WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the  
20 Traffic Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council,  
21

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of  
23 Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:  
24

25 Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic  
26 Control File is hereby amended as follows:  
27

- 28 1. Add signage designating southbound Lillis Drive at Portage Trail as  
29 right lane right turn /straight lane only and left lane left turn only.
- 30 2. Add signage designating northbound Cody Avenue at Portage Trail as  
31 left lane left turn only, center lane straight only and right lane right  
32 turn only.
- 33 3. Prohibit left turn movements into and out of the State Road entrance  
34 to 2816 State Road (Get Go).
- 35 4. Prohibit left turn movements into and out of the State Road entrances  
36 on either side of 2855 State Road (Portage Crossing Outlot 2).
- 37 5. Prohibit parking on both sides of all streets under 26' wide in the  
38 Hidden Lakes allotment. The roads include: Lake Forest Drive (24'),  
39 Hidden Valley Court (24'), Parkview Court (24'), Lake View Drive (24')  
40 and Little Brook Drive (24').
- 41 6. Prohibit parking on the EVEN side of Hidden Lake Lane.
- 42 7. Add a stop intersection on Hidden Lake Lane at Lake View Drive.
- 43 8. Add a stop intersection on Little Brook Drive at Hidden Lake Lane.
- 44 9. Replace the existing two (2) way stop intersection at Shaw Ave. and  
45 23<sup>rd</sup> Street with a four (4) way stop intersection.  
46

47 Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note in  
48 the Traffic Control File the proper legends.  
49

50 Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the  
51 installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

52  
53 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances  
54 and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances  
55 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent  
56 herewith and which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and  
57 confirmed.

58  
59 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
60 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an  
61 open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of  
62 any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open  
63 to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107  
64 of the Codified Ordinances.

65  
66 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
67 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience  
68 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and  
69 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or  
70 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
71 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force  
72 at the earliest period allowed by law.
