 WHEREAS, on June 2, 2015 the Planning Commission recommended approval a zoning map amendment for parcels 35-00857, 35-02577 and 35-00103, from MU-3 Sub-Urban Center to E-1 Employment District. The zoning map amendment is approximately 5.43 acres on Wyoga Lake Road, approximately 450 feet north of Steels Corners Road. The map amendment is fully described in Project File MAP-15-00013.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:


