A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES CLEAN OHIO TRAILS FUND GRANT TO CONSTRUCT A TRAIL AND TRAILHEAD IN THE MUD BROOK GREENWAY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the Clean Ohio Trails Fund (COTF); and

WHEREAS, a grant is available from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources in an amount of up to \$850,000; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires an estimated local cost share match of 25% of the total project cost; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls desires financial assistance through the COTF Program to construct a trail and trailhead in the Mud Brook Greenway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to apply for a grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources Clean Ohio Trails Fund (COTF) to construct a trail and trailhead in the Mud Brook Greenway.

Section 2. The Mayor, Director of Community Development Department, Director of Law, and other city officials, as appropriate, are hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and to execute, certify or furnish such other documents and do all other things, as are necessary for and incidental to carrying out the grant application and this ordinance.

Section 3. The City of Cuyahoga Falls does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the COTF Program, including the local cost share match of 25% of the total project cost.
