5 ORDINANCE NO. 4 - 2012

7 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 99-2011,  
8 RELATING TO THE PURCHASE OF SELF-CONTAINED  
9 BREATHING APPARATUS SETS, AND DECLARING AN  
10 EMERGENCY.

11  
12 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State  
13 of Ohio, that:

14  
15 Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 99-2011, passed November 28, 2011 is hereby  
16 amended to read in full as follows:

18 The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
19 contracts, according to law, for the purchase of not to exceed fifty (50) self-contained  
20 breathing apparatus sets, extra face pieces, and a Rescue Intervention Team pack for  
21 use by the Fire Department.

22  
23 Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
24 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of  
25 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been  
26 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

27  
28 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
29 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and  
30 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
31 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including  
32 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

33  
34 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
35 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
36 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
37 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
38 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
39 period allowed by law.
