NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Council hereby finds and determines that three (3) Raleigh bicycles and fifteen (15) police tactical vests owned by the City are no longer needed for municipal purposes and/or have become obsolete.

Section 2. Notwithstanding and as an exception to Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract without competitive bidding with Summa Health System, Inc. ("Summa") for the transfer to Summa of (3) Raleigh bicycles no longer needed by the City, in exchange for which Summa shall provide Cuyahoga Falls police officers with access to law enforcement training classes in such quantity as, in the opinion of the Mayor, equals or exceeds the value of the bicycles transferred.

Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to donate fifteen (15) obsolete police tactical vests to other law enforcement agencies as the Mayor may determine.

Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and Section 4. resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and

which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
