Section 1. Sections 945.02, 945.04, 945.06, and 945.14 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls are hereby amended to read in full as follows (new text underlined; deleted text in strikethrough):

#### 945.02 Definitions

As used in this chapter, the following terms are defined as follows:

- (a) "Cemetery" refers to all cemeteries owned by the City of Cuyahoga Falls.
- (b) "Columbarium" means a vault with niches for urns containing the ashes of cremated human remains.
- (c) "Cemetery section" means a subdivision of a cemetery as depicted on a cemetery map.
- (d) "Cremation garden" means a designated area in Oakwood Cemetery for the sole purpose of interment of cremations.
- (e) "Crypt" or "vault" means a space in a mausoleum of sufficient size used, or intended to be used, to entomb uncremated human remains.
- (f) "Designated cremation plots" means those plots designated, due to their size, for cremation burial only.
- (g) "Director of Public Service" means the Director of Public Service of the City of Cuyahoga Falls or his/her designee.
  - (h) "Entombment" means the placement of human remains in a crypt or vault.
- (i) "Grave" means an interchangeable term describing a plot or niche in which the remains of a deceased person are interred.
- (j) "Infant plot" means those plots designated, due to their size, for infant burial only.(k) "Inurnment," means the placement of human cremated remains in an urn which is placed into a niche.
  - (l) "Lot," means a subdivision of a cemetery section as depicted on a cemetery map.
- (m) "Marker" means a bronze or granite tablet set flush with the established ground/earth grade.
  - (n) "Mausoleum" means any above ground burial structure.
  - (o) "Memorial" means a marker, upright monument, or crypt or niche name plate.
- (p) "Niche" means a space in a columbarium used, or intended to be used, for inurnment of cremated human remains.
  - (q) "Nonresident" means a person who is not a resident of the City.
- (r) "Owners" refers to plot or grave owners who are defined as persons who have been deeded specific plots, or who have established a right to succeed in ownership in accordance with City ordinances.
- (s) "Perpetual Care Endowment" means monies received for the purpose of perpetual care of the plots. Such charges shall be paid in full at the time of purchase and shall not be deferred under any circumstances. Perpetual Care only covers general maintenance of cemetery plots, it does not cover special care of headstones, plantings, or miscellaneous items.

- (t) "Plot" means a space within a lot of a cemetery used or intended to be used for earth burial; one grave.
  - (u) "Resident" means a person who meets at least one of the following criteria:
    - (1) Currently resides in the City of Cuyahoga Falls;
- (2) Resided in the City of Cuyahoga Falls immediately prior to entering a care facility; or
- (3) In the case where the grave or niche to be purchased is for a deceased person, one plot or niche may be available to that person at a resident rate provided:
  - A. He/she was a resident at the time of his/her death; or
- B. He/she was a resident immediately prior to enrolling in a college or university, or entering active service in the United States armed services.
- (v) "Vault" or "c<u>Crypt" means a space in a mausoleum of sufficient size used, or intended to be used, to entomb uncremated human remains. means a lined and sealed outer container for a casket. Vaults must be constructed of steel or concrete.</u>
- (w) "Veteran" means those individuals recognized for Veteran's status by the Federal Government.

#### 945.04 Deferred Payments; Sale and Cancellation Upon Default.

If not paid for in full at the time of purchase, plots or niches may be sold upon the following terms: one third (1/3) cash on the day of sale, the remaining two thirds (2/3) within one (1) year from the date of the sale. Such deferred payments shall be secured by the promissory note of the purchaser, and such notes shall not bear interest until due. No deed shall be delivered until the entire purchase price has been paid. No marker, memorial or niche plate shall be placed, nor shall a burial be permitted on such plot or in such niche, until the full purchase price has been paid, and in the case of a burial, a burial permit has been received by the Director of Public Service. Upon default in the payment of the purchase price of any plot or niche purchased after June 1, 1968, the City shall have the right, upon first giving thirty (30) days written notice by registered mail addressed to the purchaser of record or, if the name and/or address of such purchaser cannot be ascertained, by publication for one (1) time in a newspaper published in the City or the County, to declare the sale of such plot or niche canceled. Thereupon all rights of such purchaser to such plot or niche shall be terminated and any payments thereon shall stand forfeited to the City as liquidated damages for failure to purchase such plot or niche.

### 945.04 Rules and Regulations

Except as specifically stated herein, the Director of Public Service may establish rules and regulations for the operation of City cemeteries. A copy of the rules and regulations shall be maintained in the office of the Director of Public Service.

(b) Records of all sales and transfers and owners of all plots or niches shall be made and kept in the Office of the Director of Public Service.

# 945.14 SUPERVISION OF CHILDREN; CERTAIN FLOWERS PROHIBITED; VEHICLES.

(a) Children shall not be allowed on the cemetery grounds unless accompanied by parents or other responsible persons.

- (b) Flowers of the field daisy are particularly noxious and shall not be brought into the cemetery. Any bouquet found containing them will be destroyed.

  (c) (b) Vehicles shall not be driven onto lots or lawns. No vehicle shall be parked or left
  - (e) (b) Vehicles shall not be driven onto lots or lawns. No vehicle shall be parked or left on a road or driveway within the cemetery in such a position as to prevent another vehicle from passing. Vehicles in the cemetery shall obey all posted traffic signs.

Section 945.15 through 945.99 No Changes Required.

<u>Section 3.</u> Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

 <u>Section 4.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

<u>Section 5.</u> This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
