Mr. Brillhart called the meeting to order at 9:10 p.m. All members were present.

Discussion:

Temp. Ord. B-11

An ordinance amending the Traffic Control File by providing for installation of various traffic control devices, and declaring an emergency.

Police Chief Jack Davis presented Temporary Ordinance B-11. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File is hereby amended as follows:

1. Prohibit parking on the east side of 27th Street from 2211 – 27th Street to the north side of 2251 – 27th Street.
2. Install a traffic light at the entrance of GOJO; 3783 State Road.
3. Update the Traffic File to include the following items at Woodland Villas and Woodland Preserve Development:
 - Stop sign on East Woodland Drive at Sourek Trail.
 - Stop sign on West Woodland Drive at Sourek Trail.
 - Stop sign on South Woodland Drive at West Woodland Drive.
 - 25 MPH speed limit signs posted on East, West & South Woodland Drives.
 - NO OUTLET sign posted on East Woodland Drive at Sourek Trail.
 - NO OUTLET sign posted on West Woodland Drive at Sourek Trail.

Mr. Pallotta moved to bring out Temp. Ord. B-11 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mr. Reilly. Motion passed (3-0).

Temp. Ord. B-12

An ordinance amending Chapter 929, Storm Drainage Utility, of the Codified Ordinances, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Tony Demasi, Engineer, presented Temporary Ordinance B-12. This ordinance establishes methods for controlling the introduction of pollutants into the MS4 to comply with requirements

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of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (“NPDES”) permit process as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (“Ohio EPA”).

Mr. Reilly moved to bring out Temp. Ord. B-12 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mr. Pallotta. Motion passed (3-0).
