Discussion:

Temp. Ord. A-13

An ordinance amending the Traffic Control File by providing for installation of various traffic control devices, and declaring an emergency.

Police Chief Jack Davis presented Temporary Ordinance A-13 to Council. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File will be amended as follows:

1. Prohibit parking on both sides of Bolanz Road between Akron Peninsula Road and Riverview Road.
2. Prohibit parking on both sides of Ira Road within the City limits.
3. Prohibit parking on both sides of Riverview Road within the City limits.
4. Prohibit parking on both sides of Akron Peninsula Road within the City limits.
5. Update the traffic file for The Villages at Sycamore Development as follows:
 - Stop signs on Alanson Circle at Akron-Peninsula Road
 - Stop sign on Alanson Avenue at Alanson Circle
 - Stop signs on private drives North & South Eckert Lane, Frank Court, Springer Court, Mud Brook Lane and Bean Lane at Alanson Avenue
 - 25 MPH speed limit signs posted on Alanson Circle for the entire development
 - Prohibit parking on the odd side of Alanson Avenue
 - NO OUTLET signs posted on Alanson Circle for the entire development
6. Post signs for the 4 parallel parking spaces located on Portage Trail in front of Portage Community Bank (140 Portage Trail) to allow 1-hour parking from 8:00am – 5:00pm.
7. Prohibit parking on either side of Hidden Lake Lane within 200 feet of State Road.

Mr. John Szalay, and Mrs. Paula Szalay, 581 Lake of the Woods Boulevard, Akron, and Bruce Gagnon, Chief Ranger, Cuyahoga Valley National Park, spoke in favor of Temporary Ordinance A-13.

Temp. Ord. A-14

The Mayor will be authorized to enter into a NOPEC Energized Community Grant Agreement with NOPEC, Inc. for energy efficiency or energy infrastructure projects. The Mayor, Director of Public Service, Director of Law and other necessary City officials will be authorized to provide such other information and to execute such other documents and do all other actions as are necessary for and incidental to carrying out the requirements of this ordinance and the terms of the Grant Agreement.

Mr. Miller moved to bring out Temp. Ord. A-14 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mrs. Spinner Motion passed (3-0).
