**Discussion:**

**Temp. Ord. B-27**

An ordinance enacting new Title Nine, Chapter 951 “Management, Administration and Control of the Use of the City’s Public Rights-of-Way” into the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.

Police Chief Jack Davis presented this ordinance before Council. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File is hereby amended as follows: 1. Prohibit parking on the odd (east) side of Billman Place from Portage Trail to the southernmost property line of 2343 Billman Place.

Ms. Nichols-Rhodes stated that, at one point, more people were opposed to restricting parking on both sides, because there's already no parking on one side. The area that this talks about is a short amount right off of Portage Trail. The owner of the properties was the person requesting it, so it doesn't affect any other people. Mr. Reilly stated that only two legal spaces that were impacted.

Mr. Pallotta moved to bring out Temp. Ord. B-27 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mr. Brillhart. Motion passed (3-0).

**Temp. Ord. B-30**

An ordinance amending the Traffic Control File by providing for installation of various traffic control devices, and declaring an emergency.

Police Chief Jack Davis presented Temporary Ordinance B-30. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File is hereby amended as follows: Prohibit parking Monday through Friday from 6:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. on Maitland Circle between the addresses of 2650 and 2680 Maitland Circle.

Mr. Brillhart moved to bring out Temp. Ord. B-30 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mr. Mr. Pallotta. Motion passed (3-0).
