Temp. Ord. B-10

An ordinance amending the Traffic Control File by providing for installation of various traffic control devices, and declaring an emergency.

Police Chief Jack Davis presented Temporary Ordinance B-10 to Council. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File is hereby amended as follows:

1. Request to move the “No Parking between these Signs” sign located on the 2100 block of 8th Street to a location between 2103 8th Street and Leavitt Avenue on the east side of the street.
2. Request to move the “No Parking between these Signs” sign located on the 2100 block of 9th Street to a location between 2103 9th Street and Leavitt Avenue on the east side of the street.

The Chief of Police will be authorized and directed to note in the Traffic Control File the proper legends. The Mayor will be authorized and directed to cause the installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

Ms. Nichols-Rhodes thanked Chief Davis and the Traffic Committee for being very responsive. There was a curve on all three of those streets, and a resident felt it was unsafe to pull out of the driveway being on the curve. They then realized that two other blocks had the same issue and another resident requested it. It is good for everybody's safety.

Mr. Miller moved to bring out Temp. Ord. B-10 with a favorable recommendation, second by Ms. Loza. Motion passed (3-0).
