Jeff Iula has also done an outstanding job. He is an interesting and passionate voice of the City.

Mrs. Pyke stated she agreed with the Mayor. She read Ms. Mongold's resume and was very impressed. She stated that the Richardson Science Fair was fantastic and commented that it takes a special person to be so dedicated and do such a fine job. She thanked Ms. Mongold for giving her time to that endeavor.

Mrs. Hummel echoed Mrs. Pyke's comments and thanked everyone for volunteering in the community. That is important. Council gets a lot of perspective from the various volunteers and feels the City needs that.
