- Call to Order:** Mrs. Klinger, as senior member, at 6:33 p.m.
- Mrs. Klinger accepted nominations for Temporary Chair. Mr. Walters nominated Mr. James. No second was required. There were no further nominations. Motion passed unanimously, voice vote (11-0). Mr. James is Temporary Chair.
