**Temp. Ord. B-131**

An ordinance levying special assessments for the repair or replacement of sidewalks and drive approaches in the Sidewalk and Drive Approach Repair and Replacement District, for the year 2015, and declaring an emergency.

Mrs. Klinger asked Mr. Demasi or Mr. Hoffman to send a complete list of sidewalks and drive approaches repaired in the year 2015. Mr. Demasi stated that he would do that the next day. Mr. Demasi stated that last year was a great year and they were looking forward to starting the projects this year.

Mrs. Pyke stated that, out of all her years serving on Council, last year was one of the best years for sidewalk improvements. She commended the Department for doing a good job of going into neighborhoods and finding sections of sidewalks needing to be repaired. Mrs. Pyke stated that she received no communication from constituents complaining about being forced to replace an entire frontage that they didn't think needed done. She stated she felt the money was spent wisely, spending money only on sidewalks that were truly in need of repair.

Mrs. Pyke then asked Mr. Demasi about the apron program. Mr. Demasi stated that 51 drive approaches were replaced, representing one of the highest, most-successful years of the program.

Mrs. Klinger moved to bring out Temp. Ord. B-131 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mr. Brillhart. Motion passed (3-0).
