Minutes of the Public Improvements Committee Meeting

January 6, 2014

Call to Order The meeting was called to order by Chairman Iula at 7:10 p.m. A quorum was present.

Approval of the Minutes Without objection, the minutes of the December 2, 2013 and December 16, 2013 Committee meetings were approved.

Agenda Items

Temp. Res. B-112 A resolution creating for the year 2014 a Sidewalk and Drive Approach Repair or Replacement District containing such streets, alleys, or public roadways within the corporate limits of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, declaring the necessity of repairing or replacing the sidewalks and drive approaches abutting on such streets, alleys or public roadways within said corporate limits and providing the method for levying special assessments, and declaring an emergency.

Proponent testimony was offered by the City Engineer Tony Demasi. The Chairman recognized Mrs. Pyke, who asked whether the number of sidewalk requests pending would allow further additions to the program for 2014. Mr. Demasi stated that the 2013 program had completed most of the outstanding requests, there is available capacity in 2014, and that parties seeking work to be done during 2014 should contact his office. Ms. Pyke stated that a previous proposal to relocate a bus stop from Sackett Avenue to Second Street was prevented by there being a lack of sidewalks on the block bordered by Second, Fourth, Falls and Sackett. Mr. Demasi stated that his office would consider this block for inclusion in the program in 2014.

There was no opponent testimony. There was no public comment.

Motion by Mr. Mader to release Temp. Res. B-112 with a favorable recommendation. Seconded by Mrs. Snyder. Motion adopted by acclamation.

Temp. Ord. B-113

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the replacement or adjustment of concrete sidewalks, drive approaches and curbs at various locations in the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and declaring an emergency.

Proponent testimony was offered by the City Engineer Tony Demasi. There was no opponent testimony. There was no public comment.


