

**Cuyahoga Falls City Council
Minutes of the Public Affairs Committee Meeting
October 15, 2012**

Mr. Walters called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. All members were present.

The minutes from the October 1, 2012 Committee meeting were approved as submitted.

Sub. Temp. Ord. A-109 (dated 10/15/12)

An ordinance amending the Traffic Control File by providing for installation of various traffic control devices, and declaring an emergency.

Chuck Novak stated that the Traffic Committee approved five changes. The first is to prohibit parking on the east side of Maplewood. The street is narrow and it is difficult to get sanitation and plow trucks through if vehicles are parked on both sides of the streets. The second and third items are site distance issues. Vehicles park too close to the intersection at Richmond and Issaquah making it difficult for school buses to make the turn. The fourth item is also a site distance issue. There is already restricted parking at the sharp curve for odd numbered addresses 2345 to 2369 Richmond Rd. This just adds one more address, which is 2339 Richmond. The fifth item restricts parking on the north side of Marguerite from the driveway at 133 Marguerite to Bailey Road.

Mr. Walters stated there was a typo on line 39 with the addresses "2305 and 2339." That has been changed to 2339-2369. Mr. James thanked the Traffic Committee for addressing numbers 2, 3 and 4.

Mrs. Klinger moved to bring out Sub. Temp. Ord. A-109 (dated 10/15/12) with a favorable recommendation, second by Mrs. Snyder. Motion passed (3-0).

The meeting adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
