Temp. Res. B-100

A resolution authorizing the Director of Public Service to apply for and accept financial assistance in the form of a grant from the U.S. Dept. of Transportation, through the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS), for the resurfacing of Main Street between Howe Avenue and the southern corporation limit, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Demasi stated that Akron contacted the City regarding an AMATS fund application they were preparing for Home Avenue/Main Street. It is a joint project so support legislation is required from both sponsors. Akron has submitted a letter of intent and signed legislation is due November 19. This project is to resurface the street with 3" asphalt with full-depth where needed and to update handicap ramps. Main Street was last paved in 1998. The length of the project is 668 feet which is approximately 1/8 mile. The City's estimated share is 20% of the total cost which is around \$16,000. This is contingent on Akron getting funding.

Mr. Mader moved to bring out B-100 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mr. Walters. Motion passed (2-0).
