**Temp. Ord. B-119**

An ordinance subdividing the City into wards pursuant to the 2010 Federal Decennial Census, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Ihasz moved to adopt Temp. Ord. B-119, second by Mrs. Hummel. Mr. Walters stated this redistricting ordinance is the compilation of many hours of research and debate. The one thing that was learned was that there is no perfect proposal, but the Committee's selection that is before Council surpasses all of the goals of the Charter without any of the political division of 2001. He encouraged bipartisan support to move us through the next decade with the residents in mind as opposed to the political posturing of the past. He respectfully asked for everyone's support.
