**Temp. Ord. B-14**

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts according to law, for replacement of the sanitary sewer on 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup> Streets, between Lincoln Avenue and Silver Lake Avenue, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Demasi stated they are upgrading this area in phases. The third phase is to upgrade the 8" line on 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Streets to a 12" sanitary sewer line. Seventeen bids were received. It is an Ohio Public Works project with OPW paying for half of the project. Mr. Walters asked about the size of the new upgrade and about infiltration. Mr. Demasi stated the upgrade will be plastic and will also allow for some inline pipe storage. Mrs. Ritzinger asked when the project would be completed. Mr. Demasi indicated it would be completed by July or August 2009. Mrs. Pyke asked about flow. Mr. Demasi indicated it flows from south to north into the Silver Lake Avenue line, which is also a 12" line.
