Mr. James called the meeting to order at 6:38 p.m. All members were present.

Temp. Ord. B-17

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Safety to enter into a contract without competitive bidding with the Valley Fire District for the sale of a fire truck no longer needed for any municipal purpose, and declaring an emergency.

Chief Moledor stated it was discussed in budget to replace Engine 4. At that time, they looked at increasing the size of the tank, which they have done. This has left the department with a tanker to either sell back to Finley or sell outright. The value is worth \$55,000 to \$60,000 but the trade-in value is only \$30,000. At the time they were purchasing the new tanker, Valley Fire's tanker broke. The City will be selling the old tanker to Valley Fire, who agreed to pay the higher value of \$60,000 due to the low mileage. This is a win-win for both the City and Valley Fire.

Mr. James stated that Valley Fire should be thrilled to have this tanker. He agreed it is a win-win situation for both departments, and the City will be getting some revenue.

Mr. Barnhart moved to bring out Temp. Ord. B-17 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mr. Colavecchio. Motion passed (3-0).

The meeting adjourned at 6:41 p.m.
