**Temp. Ord. A-37**

An ordinance approving the issuance of bonds by Franklin County, Ohio in relation to certain hospital facilities located within the City of Cuyahoga Falls, pursuant to Section 147 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Janis stated this indicates Council's approval in support of bonds issued on behalf of certain hospital facilities throughout the state. These facilities are beneficiaries of bond proceeds that are rendered tax-exempt. The IRS requires that the public authorities where the facilities are located approve the issuance of the bonds. The City is not responsible for any of the debt service. On April 9, the lawyers for the bond issuing authority will come before Council for a public hearing.

Mrs. Klinger moved to bring out A-37 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mrs. Snyder. Motion passed (2-0).

**Temp. Ord. A-38**

An ordinance changing the name of Hampton Bluff Drive to Nestico Drive, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Demasi stated that the City received a petition from all property owners on Hampton Bluff Drive requesting this name change. It was reviewed by the Planning & Zoning Department, who found it was in compliance with the Code. The Engineering Department will make the changes to the official City map and will notify the appropriate entities, such as the post office, elections board, etc. He stated that the road is located in the Hampton Bluff Subdivision off Zorn Drive. There were two residents who filed the petition. One owns one property and the other owns the remaining 25 properties. The street is a dedicated street.

Mrs. Klinger moved to bring out A-38 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mrs. Snyder. Motion passed (2-0).
