**Temp. Ord. A-57**

An ordinance authorizing payment of the Moral Claim of Patricia J. Schilling as approved by the Claims Commission, and declaring an emergency

Mr. Arrington stated that Mrs. Schilling had a sewer back-up caused by a blockage in the City line. The total claim submitted was \$2,346 which included \$1,200 in items destroyed and clean-up costs. After applying a depreciation formula to the items in the basement, the amount came to \$1,700. Mrs. Schilling also has a sidewalk assessment of \$850. Therefore, the settlement is \$850 in cash plus credit for the amount owed on the sidewalk replacement program for a total payment of \$1,700. Mrs. Hummel asked if Mrs. Schilling agreed with this settlement. Mr. Arrington stated she did and added that she was present at the Claims Commission meeting the previous week. He usually tells residents that while they're welcome to attend the Council meeting on their claim, it is not necessary for them to be present.
