Temp. Ord. A-28 An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Safety

to accept a Justice Assistance Grant subgrant from

the Department of Public Safety, making an

appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Proponent testimony was offered by the Police Chief Jack Davis, who stated that the City has applied for a grant in order to support the purchase of a piece of equipment, and that grant has been approved. The ordinance permits the City to use funds from its federal forfeiture account to pay the City's share of the purchase. Sgt. Singleton described and demonstrated the device: a pole camera with a detachable remote controlled motorized camera with wheels. The Chair asked if the device records video. Sgt. Singleton stated that that feature is available at extra cost. The total cost of the device as proposed is \$2,500.

The Chair recognized Mrs. Pyke, who asked who is writing grants for the Police Dept. Chief Davis stated there is no assigned grants writer. The Chief himself writes many of the grant applications.

There was no opponent testimony. There was no public comment.

Motion by Mr. Iula to release Temp. Ord. A-28 with a favorable recommendation. Seconded by Mrs. Klinger. Motion adopted by acclamation.
