Temp. Ord. B-27

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the reconstruction of concrete pavement at various locations in the City, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Demasi stated that this year they will begin in the Wyoga Lake Business Park. They will be working on Cochran Road from Cavalier Trail to the dead-end of Cochran Road for a distance of 400 feet, and Cavalier Trail from Cochran to Remington for a distance of 600 feet. This is the third year of the project. The roads will be 8" thick with a 12" base and reinforced joints. It will be open to thru traffic. Bids will be opened next Monday and, if approved, the anticipated completion date is mid September.

Mr. Ihasz moved to bring out Temp. Ord. B-27 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mrs. Pyke. Motion passed (3-0).

Other Business

Mrs. Pyke asked if legislation would be coming soon for the waterline on Chestnut. Mrs. Carr stated the numbers are still being reviewed. It was possible the legislation could be in the next Council packet.
