Mr. James called the meeting to order at 6:48 p.m. All members were present.

Temp. Ord. B-66

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement known as the Summit County Intergovernmental Memorandum of Understanding for Job Creation and Retention and Tax Revenue Sharing, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

Mrs. Truby stated this is for the 2011 job preservation agreement. This is the third year it has been in existence. It was originally created by Summit County to encourage cooperation between communities. Some communities who have signed on this year include Barberton, Mogadore, Sagamore Hills, Silver Lake, Fairlawn and Macedonia. Norton and Stow have voted to not be included, and Cuyahoga Falls and Akron are pending. Mr. Demasi stated that on the three projects discussed a few weeks earlier, each received an additional 12 points because the City was a member of this agreement. The City received a total of 132 points for the State Road project. If it had not been a member, there would have been a deduction of 12 points so there is actually a 24-point swing. Mrs. Pyke asked if there have been any changes in this contract from last year's contract. Mrs. Truby stated it was generally just fine tuning. Previously, a community had to wait a year before being able to withdraw and now it could withdraw after a 30-day notice. Mrs. Pyke asked for a list of the changes prior to next week. Mrs. Truby stated she would do that.

Mr. Rubino moved to approve bringing B-66 out of Committee with a favorable recommendation, second by Mrs. Pyke. Motion passed (3-0).
