Mr. Pallotta called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m. All members were present.

Temp. Ord. B-50

An ordinance rescheduling the regular City Council and Council Committee meetings in July 2017, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Pallotta stated that this ordinance will allow Council to have the July 4th week off and have the regularly-scheduled Council meeting through July 31st. Council will then go into recess for the month of August.

Mrs. Pyke stated that she wanted to thank Mrs. Klinger for bringing this to her attention. Typically, Council is called to a special meeting the last Monday of the month so they don't have an entire month waiting for legislation that may need to be passed. This way, it will move the Committee meetings to the second and fourth Monday of July and the Council meetings to the third and fifth Monday of July.

Mr. Miller moved to bring out Temp. Ord. B-50 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mr. James. Motion passed (3-0).

Mrs. Susan Truby, 2976 Devan Vale, stated that she has watched with great interest the reopening of Front Street. Ever since that has been announced, she has had people question her as to what is going to happen to the engraved brick wall. She came tonight to find out exactly what the plans for the engraved brick would be. Mayor Walters stated that the bricks will be reused and/or replicated. In addition, they are going to have new ones available to be incorporated, as well. They will be less expensive than the first time around. Every brick will be back in the new site northeast of where they are now. There will be surface brick around the new splash pad for the children. Mrs. Truby asked if the bricks will be in a walkway rather than a wall. Mayor Walters stated that was correct. Mrs. Truby asked if the 52 bricks that have logos on them are going to be replicated, as well. Mayor Walters stated that everything that is there will remain. Mrs. Truby asked if the four assorted sizes of brick will remain the same. Mayor Walters stated that he would verify that with Belden Brick Company, through W.L. Tucker Supply Company, but it is his

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understanding that those will all be replicated in the same size, same writing and same logo. That was one of the requirements from the start. Mrs. Truby stated that it is a very important part of history from Falls River Square. She thanked Mayor Walters for taking the time to answer her questions. Mayor Walters stated that the new bricks will be available on the City's website and on the Falls Downtown site starting next week.

Mr. Miller moved to bring out Temp. Ord. B-50 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mr. James. Motion passed (3-0).
