Temp. Ord. B-41

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the replacement of a 16" water main in Graham Road, from Bath Road to Graham Road Circle, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Demasi stated the existing 16" water line has experienced several breaks. It was originally installed in 1958. In 2012, the City applied for and received Ohio Public Works funding for half the cost. The Engineering Department has completed the design, the project has been bid and will be awarded upon Council's approval. They anticipate working beginning sometime in August and will be completed by the end of the year. Work will be take place mostly on the south side of the street. There will be some traffic headaches but the road is four lanes so that allows for some options in maintaining the traffic pattern. Graham Road Circle is where the Red Lobster is.

Mr. Ihasz moved to bring out Temp. Ord. B-41 with a favorable recommendation, second by Mrs. Pyke. Motion passed (3-0).
