Temp. Ord. B-64

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the reconstruction of concrete pavement at various locations in the City, and declaring an emergency.

Mrs. Carr stated they are doing further a analysis on bids because there are other areas in the City where concrete streets did not fair very well due to the harsh winter. She had planned to have a list of new areas to discuss tonight, however, they are not quite ready with it so she is hoping to have another committee meeting in two weeks to get it handled before Council's break.

Mr. Walters stated the Committee will continue to hold B-64.

Temp. Ord. B-69

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the repair and resurfacing of Portage Trail from 4th Street to 13th Street, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Demasi stated the City applied for funding through AMATS on various projects and received grants for two of them. One is this project. This section of Portage Trail was last paved in 1995 and is 3/4 mile long. Bids were opened last month and sent to ODOT for approval. The project should take four weeks to complete. He expects ODOT's approval to occur within the next two weeks. If so, they should be able to start sometime in August. Mr. Ihasz asked whether any curbs would be replaced with this project. Mr. Demasi stated there would be some. There are five locations which will have handicap ramps installed. They may do the curbs under the current program. Catch basins would be done on an as-needed basis.

Mr. Ihasz moved to bring B-69 out with a favorable recommendation, second by Mr. Mader. Motion passed (3-0).
