Agenda Items

Temp. Ord. A-81 An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public

Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the reconstruction of concrete pavement at various locations in the City, and declaring an

emergency.

Proponent testimony was offered by the City Engineer, Tony Demasi. Mr. Demasi stated that this year's concrete repair program will be located at two locations. The concrete parking lots located north of and south of the Green Parking Deck will be replaced. These lots were built in 1975 will be replaced with 6" thick concrete using MS concrete. The bids will be opened on September 10 and will be awarded on September 15. The projects will be completed by October 31, 2014.

The Chair asked about the status of the downtown parking decks. Mr. Demasi stated those facilities are worked on every year under a different program.

The Chair recognized Mr. Mader, who asked if these project will exhaust the budget for concrete work in the 2014 budget. Mr. Demasi stated that it will.

The Chair recognized Mr. Weinhardt, who noted that the previous year's budget for concrete streets was over \$300,000, and asked if the current \$150,000 budget for concrete streets will go up in 2015. Mr. Demasi that he hopes it will go up.

The Chair recognized Mrs. Pyke, who asked about the status of grant funding to repair Howe Ave. Mr. Demasi stated that the City received a grant two years ago and is now is the process of selecting a consultant to design the project. The consultant should be under contract by the end of the year. ODOT would like the design complete in order to start construction as early as 2016. Mrs. Pyke asked what the City's plan is to maintain the road in the interim. Mr. Demasi stated that the Street Department patches these areas continuously.

There was no opponent testimony. There was no public comment.

Motion by Mrs. Snyder to release Temp. Ord. A-81 with a favorable recommendation. Seconded by Mr. Mader. Motion adopted by acclamation.
