Discussion:

Temp. Res. B-88

A resolution to adopt and participate in a Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan with the County of Summit Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.

Chief Moledor stated this is a mitigation plan adopted for Summit County and developed for County communities. It has been approved by the State of Ohio and is through the federal government. It allows the City to get reimbursed from the federal government for things like warning sirens. This legislation allows us to get those funds.

Temp. Ord. B-89

An ordinance amending the traffic control file by providing for installation of various traffic control devices, and declaring an emergency.

Capt. Davis stated there were four items on this ordinance. All of them were approved by the Traffic Control Committee. With regard to prohibiting parking on Hoch Drive, Mr. Rubino asked about the traffic. Capt. Davis stated it is a small area and prohibiting the parking will help with plowing. Mr. Rubino asked for the reason behind prohibiting parking on Hunter. Capt. Davis said with parking, there are vision restrictions because it is a narrow part of the street
