Temp. Res. B-81

A resolution consenting to the repair of the barrier wall on State Route 8 at Broad Boulevard within the City of Cuyahoga Falls, by the State of Ohio, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Demasi stated that in June of this year, ODOT contacted the City about the barrier wall being in need of repair. This is on the northbound side of Route 8. ODOT will make the repair at no cost to the City. It is scheduled to be bid next month and will be completed in 2012. ODOT requires consent legislation from cities for any work it does within a city's corporation limits. This is standard language. If there are additional expenses, the City would be responsible but he does not see anything at this point. He added that the ramp would probably be closed during the repair. Mrs. Pyke asked if it was possible that this ramp and the northbound Howe Ave. entrance ramp could be closed at the same time. Mr. Demasi stated they are two separate projects so it is a possibility but he would work with ODOT to try to avoid that.

Mr. Ihasz moved to bring out B-81 with a favorably recommendation, second by Mr. Mader. Motion passed (3-0).
