**Temp. Ord. A-109**

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract and/or contracts without competitive bidding with Kenmore Construction Co., Inc. for emergency repair to the Gorge Park sanitary sewer, and declaring an emergency.

John Christopher stated in July, they had a report from the Park Service that there was a minor leak on an 18" sanitary sewer pipe in the gorge. The pipe is 50 feet long and is located aboveground. Kenmore Construction was able to come out to do a temporary repair. There is money in the budget under Miscellaneous Sewer Repair to complete the work. Only the temporary repair was made. This ordinance will allow Kenmore to come in and complete the repair. He did not feel the work would exceed the \$37,250 stated on the budget sheet. Mrs. Klinger asked how this was different from the project approved by A-50 to bury the sewer line. Mr. Christopher stated this is quite a distance from that project and are not related to each other. Mrs. Pyke asked where in the gorge this was. Mr. Christopher stated it was approximately 1/4 mile from the parking lot off Front Street along the lower path. It was closer to the cave. Mrs. Pyke asked if the work would be accessed from the trails. Mr. Christopher indicated it would.
