



The following resolution was introduced::

Temp. Res. A-82

A resolution requesting "No Hearing" related to the new liquor permit for Shale Group LLC dba Craft Beer Bar, and declaring an emergency.

Motion by Mr. Pallotta to suspend rule 111.05(f) to permit Council's consideration of Temp. Res. A-82 without referral to committee. Seconded Mr. Mader. Mrs. Klinger called the question. Motion adopted by acclamation.

The President read the resolution. Proponent testimony was offered by the Law Director, Russell Balthis. Mr. Balthis stated that Shale Group had applied for a liquor permit some time ago, but had subsequently changed its location in the building at 1846 Front Street. This triggered another review by the Department of Liquor Control. The business owners were unaware of this until recently. The purpose of the resolution is to provide a positive declaration of Council's waiver of the right to object. Without the resolution, Council's right to object would not expire until 30 days after the date of the notice. This will allow the business to open on Wednesday, August 27.

The President thanked the members of Council for appearing for the special meeting.

The President recognized Doreen Lyon (no address given), co-owner of the business, who thanked the Council for acting on the resolution at a special meeting.

Motion by Mr. Mader to adopt Temp. Res. A-82. Seconded by Mrs. Klinger. Mr. Pallotta called the question.

Motion adopted by acclamation, 11-0. The resolution was adopted.
