**Temp. Ord. A-106**

An ordinance modifying appropriations in various funds of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Gorbach read A-106 (second reading). Mr. Brodzinski said that earlier this year, the City elected to go with an outside employment agency to provide temporary and seasonal part-time workers, which guards us from worker's comp and unemployment claims. This ordinance allows for the movement of appropriations from the personal service side to the contractual side in various City departments.

*The committee recommended bringing out Temp. Ord. A-106 for approval.*
