Discussion:

Temp Ordinance A-101

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for replacement of the waterline in High Street from Broadway East to Tallmadge Road, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Demasi stated that the existing 8-inch waterline on High Street has had several breaks in a short period of time. It was installed in the 1920's. The project has been bid and Kenmore Construction has tendered the lowest bid. A total of 14 bids have been received.

Mrs. Ritzinger stated that the monies to fund this were from the monies that came in under budget on the Old Town Loop.

John Christopher stated that the waterline broke in January, 2008 and has broken a couple more times since. He brought this matter to Mr. Demasi's attention and suggested this would be a good project.

Tom Sullivan (Tallmadge Road) asked when the project would start. Mr. Demasi stated there is no assigned starting date but it could start and be completed this year.

Committee recommended bringing out Temp. Ord. No. A-101.
