Temp. Ord. A-121

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts for 23kV express feeder underground construction and conduit installation for cable replacement and street lighting, and declaring an emergency.

Bob Bye stated this would allow the City to enter into a contract for construction. This is for the installation of underground conduit on Hollywood, Roanoke and Orville between Hudson and Charles Streets and for the completion of a street-lighting project on Cedar Hill. Mrs. Klinger felt the ordinance was written a little loosely and wondered if it should be revised to state the specific projects. Mrs. Hummel asked if the project was bid. Mr. Bye stated bids will be opened on November 12. Mrs. Hummel stated perhaps the ordinance could reference the bid opening in order to clarify what is being done. Mr. Arrington stated he would have the ordinance revised to be more specific. Mrs. Pyke asked whether this was the actual installation of conduit on the north-end streets. Mr. Bye indicated it was. Mrs. Pyke asked if they would be going under the driveway and sidewalks. Mr. Bye stated they would be boring under like they did on Hollywood and added it would be used only for electric.
