February 27, 2006**

**Call to Order:** Mr. Walters at 6:30 p.m.

**Approval of Minutes:** The minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of February 13, 2006 were approved as submitted.

**Reports and Communications:**

Notice from the Ohio Division of Liquor Control regarding the transfer of a liquor permit from Starship Enterprises Inc. dba Baba O Rileys Bar & Grille (2624 State Rd., Suite A, Cuy. Falls, OH 44223) to GNG Wings Inc. dba Wings Warehouse (4165 Wyoga Lake Rd., Cuy. Falls, OH 44223). Mr. Walters asked if anyone would like to request a hearing on the permit transfer, and there was no response. He instructed the Clerk to hold the request until the next Council meeting to allow Council members to review it.

**Temp. Ord. A-31 (Finance)**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract or contracts with a firm or firms for community correctional services, and declaring an emergency.

**Temp. Ord. A-32 (Finance)**

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts to purchase certain property located at 2233 Oakwood Drive and declaring an emergency.

**Temp. Ord. A-33 (Finance)**

An ordinance authorizing payment of the moral claim of Richard and Valerie Johnston as approved by the Claims Commission, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Gorbach moved to suspend Council rules to allow a committee meeting on the same night as a Council meeting to discuss A-33, second by Mr. James. Motion passed, voice vote (11-0).

**Temp. Ord. A-34 (Finance)**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract and/or contracts, according to law, for the purchase of nine self-contained breathing apparatus units for use by the Fire Department, and declaring an emergency.

**Temp. Ord. A-35 (Public Improvements)**

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the repair of Deepwood Drive, from Deepwood Circle to the north end, and of Old Town Loop, from 2<sup>nd</sup> Street to Holloway Court, in the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and declaring an emergency.

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts for the renovation of certain property located at 2073 Bailey Road and declaring an emergency.
