Temp. Ord. A-10

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for replacement of the waterline in Treasch Drive from Bailey Road to Sedro Street, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Demasi stated the existing water line is cast iron and has been experiencing several breaks. It was installed in 1952-53. They will be replacing it with 8" ductile. They plan to award it next week and plan to have it completed before May 1. Mrs. Ritzinger added that the item was budgeted and would then be on next year's paving list

Temp. Ord. A-11

An ordinance authorizing the Parks and Recreation Board to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law for improvements and upgrades necessary to maintain a water source for the irrigation of turf grass at Brookledge Golf Course, and declaring an emergency.

Ed Stewart stated this project is a necessary upgrade. The three wells on the property that they currently operate off of are not working well. They drilled a new well two years ago. The upgrades will tie into two of the wells to give Brookledge a water supply for the next 30 years at least. It would be enough to pump 1,200 gallons per minute. He added that the amount was budgeted and that the bids come in on Wednesday. They want to get the project completed before the start of the season.

Committee recommended bringing out Temp. Ord. No. A-11.
