**Discussion:**

**Temp. Ord. B-16**

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the annual resurfacing and/or repair of various streets as described in Exhibit 'A', attached hereto, in the City of Cuyahoga Falls and declaring an emergency.

Mr. James read B-16 (second reading). Mr. Demasi said this ordinance allows for the resurfacing of various streets in the City in 2007.

*The committee recommended bringing out Temp. Ord. B-16 for approval.*

**Temp. Res. B-17**

A resolution creating for the year 2007 a sidewalk and drive approach repair or replacement district containing such streets, alleys, or public roadways within the corporate limits of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, declaring the necessity of repairing or replacing the sidewalks and drive approaches abutting on such streets, alleys or public roadways within said corporate limits and providing the method for levying special assessments, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. James read B-17 (second reading). Mr. Demasi said this resolution allows for creation of a sidewalk and drive approach repair or replacement district for 2007.

*The committee recommended bringing out Temp. Ord. B-17 for approval.*

**Temp. Ord. B-18**

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the replacement or adjustment of concrete sidewalks, drive approaches and curbs at various locations in the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. James read B-18 (second reading). Mr. Demasi said this ordinance allows the City to enter into contracts for repair or replacement of sidewalks, drive approaches and curbs.

Mrs. Pyke asked if one contractor would be doing the work this year. Mr. Demasi said yes, one bid allows for better economy of scale.
