DISCUSSION

Temp. Ord. No. B-31

Mr. Schmidt read B-31 (second reading). Mr. Pierson stated this would allow them to purchase concession items for Water Works, Brookledge and Downview. He indicated that the new facility was coming along and should be ready for them to move in by the end of April.

Committee recommended bringing out B-31.

Temp. Ord. No. B-32

Mr. Schmidt read B-32 (second reading). Mr. Pierson stated this was the annual purchase to buy chemicals for Water Works Family Aquatic Center. They will spend the same this year as last. The per unit price went down but they want to make sure they purchase enough to get through August when Council is not in session.

Committee recommended bringing out B-32.

Temp. Ord. No. B-33

Mr. Schmidt read B-33 (second reading). Mr. Pierson stated this will allow them to pay the Summit Umpire Association to handle the baseball program. They still have things to iron out.

Committee recommended bringing out B-33.

Temp. Ord. No. B-34

Mr. Schmidt read B-34 (second reading). Chief Snyder stated this will bring them to a total of six Lifepak 12s for front-line apparatus. They will replace the Lifepak 10s that are ten to twelve years old. The Lifepak 10s will move to engines, ladder trucks and backup. The units act as an external pacemaker and contribute to survival of cardiac arrest. In 2002, they have six documented cases where the units saved individuals who were in full cardiac arrest.

Committee recommended bringing out B-34.
