Mr. Walters read B-66 (second reading). Mr. Bell stated this is a current Issue 2 project going on for Ninth Street. The current plans stopped at Francis and 9th Street but did not include the intersection. This legislation adds the intersection. The cost estimates are roughly \$30,000, half of which would be paid by Issue 2 money. It would include pavement, curbs, sewer, etc. They will need to do additional work on the intersection to make sure it is graded properly. Mr. Walters asked why the intersection wasn't included originally. Mr. Bell stated at that time, they were not sure if Francis would come back wanting the improvement. It doesn't look like it will right now. Mrs. Pyke added that the ditch at that intersection is very deep and when it snows, drivers can't see it. Mrs. Hummel stated that Section 2 in the legislation talks about the money coming from Capital Projects Fund and asked if it was budgeted. Mr. Brodzinski stated there is a little piece of water and sewer and that the project came in \$38,000 under budget so they have the money for it. Mrs. Hummel asked if the legislation would be changed to indicate the revised language in Section 2. Mr. Brodzinski stated the Law Department will be getting a substitute to Council members.

Committee recommended bringing out B-66.
