**Temp. Ord. A-77**

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts with an engineering firm or firms to provide professional engineering services for storm sewer improvements, and declaring an emergency.

Mr. James read A-77 (second reading). Mr. Demasi said this ordinance is for engineering services for storm sewer improvements for the first phase of Purdue Street which includes a new pipe, lining, and other related work.

Mrs. Hummel inquired about the cost of the entire project. Mr. Demasi said the engineering cost is \$40,000; total cost is estimated at \$400,000.

Mr. Walters said he is aware of other storm water problems in the area. He asked how it was determined that Purdue should be done first. Mr. Demasi said he looked at the severity of flooding that occurred in July, 2003 and rated the streets accordingly.

***The committee recommended bringing out Temp. Ord. A-77 for approval.***
