Dick Pierson indicates that last year the city bought a portion of Mud Brook and secured access to Mud Brook from the old gun club to Bath Road. A design for a path from Metro Parks and Towpath that the Summit County Council approved sends money to communities who have a trail in mind. This is a quick grant, which needs a resolution for support. This grant is for \$10,000. George states this makes us a pioneer on this trail and they feel that if we can get this started, it will set the tone towards Stow and through the Valley. The coalition sends out the money since Summit County Council already approved it.
