B-124	An Ordinance establishing pay ranges for part-time, per diem, and special classification workers, and declaring an emergency.
B-125	An Ordinance amending section 151.06 of the codified ordinances and declaring an emergency.
B-126	An Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of employment agency services for city departments, and declaring an emergency.
B-127	An Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the rehabilitation of the waterline in Broad Boulevard from Newberry Street to State Route 8 in the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and declaring an emergency.
B-128	An Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the purchase and installation of a security system for the Falls River Square District, and declaring an emergency.
B-129	An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to grant a license to Alltel for the use of a portion of city property for the installation of telecommunications equipment, and declaring an emergency.
B-130	An Ordinance amending the traffic control file by providing for the installation of traffic control devices, and declaring an emergency.
B-131	A Resolution supporting the volunteer efforts of various organization and individuals in aiding homeowners with free safety inspections of their heating systems, and declaring an emergency.
