Minutes of the Finance and Appropriations Committee Meeting

March 1, 2004

Mr. Flinn called the Finance Committee to order at 7:08 p.m. All members of Committee were present. The minutes from February 17, 2004 Finance and Appropriations Committee meeting were approved as submitted.

Legislation this evening (second readings):

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| A-43 | A resolution authorizing the pick up by the City of Cuyahoga Falls, OH of the 10% mandatory contributions by Police Department employees who are members of the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund, and declaring an emergency. |
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| A-44 | A resolution authorizing the pick up by the City of Cuyahoga Falls, OH of the 10% mandatory contributions by Fire Department employees who are members of the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund, and declaring an emergency. |
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Joe Brodzinski, Finance Director, indicates that this ordinance is requested by the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund and the Administration is submitting two resolutions for consistency where the police/fire department employees and their 10% deduction is tax exempt. The pension system wants consistent resolutions to comply with their request on file. The City already has a resolution in place where their 10% pension is tax exempt (the contribution). The pension system wants it on their board records separately for police and fire. The Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund requested a record of this by the end of April 2004. It is not something that we are not already doing and have been doing for years.
