Minutes of the PUBLIC AFFAIRS COMMITTEE Meeting

May 2, 2005

Mary Ellen Pyke brought the Public Affairs Committee to order at 7:14 p.m. All member of the Committee were present. The minutes of 4/18/05 were approved as submitted.

Scheduled legislation (second reading):

B-64	An Ordinance to change the street name of Akron-Cleveland Road to State Road from Seasons Road North to the Cuyahoga Falls City Limits, and declaring an emergency.

Tony indicates he received a petition from the Tamsin Park development requesting a change of name from Akron-Cleveland Road to State Road. It is a very simple change. Everything up to Seasons Road is named State Road since the merger according to Mr. Potts.

B-65	An Ordinance authorizing the transfer and assignment of rights and obligations of KMC Telecom III, LLC, to Centurytel Acquisitions, LLC, dba KMC Telecom III, and declaring an emergency.

Virgil Arrington indicates that back in 1999, the City entered into an agreement for a fiber optic system to use our utility poles, etc. KMC Telecom is transferring its assets to the new corporation and the agreements will stay the same, we are just transferring licensing agreement.

e-Government Power Point presentation by John Konich:

Mr. Konich presented a Power Point presentation on the Information Services of CFO (Cuyahoga Falls Online). In January, IS began the hardware installation of the i550 to store our information. In February, IS began software and security installation and displayed the safeguards that are in place to protect residents from Identity Fraud. The Portal Development has begun and on June 27, 2005, we plan to have a Pilot program followed the "Live" introduction on July 11th.
