Bob Bye, Electric Superintendent indicates that the City budgeted for the Towpath area and have secured bids. Since we have secured several bids, we can cap at line 21. Mr. Bye states that by delaying this process for two years, it benefits the residents who asked if we waited to build the system and there will be a savings of \$220,000. The existing lines are not in conduit, and this is part of the long term plan of updating their needs.
