Minutes of the Public and Industrial Improvements Committee Meeting May 16, 2005

Mr. Potts called the Public and Industrial Improvements Committee to order at 6:48 p.m. All members of Committee were present. The minutes from the 4-18-05 Public and Industrial Improvements Committee meeting were approved as submitted.

Scheduled legislation:

B-70	An Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for repairs to the North and South Parking Decks in the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and declaring an emergency.

Tony indicates we will be sealing and doing repairs to railings, landing areas, drains and to the deck coating. We will go through the bid process for these repairs. There are additional repairs as compared to what we did last year. Mr. Flinn asks how long until this will be done? Tony indicates we will try to work during the week and keep it available on the weekends. The process should take around 5 months.

B-71	An Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the installation of the Woodridge Sanitary Sewer, Phase 4, and declaring an emergency.

Valerie indicates this is the Kellybrook/Antionette sewer line. She indicates we have 60% of the people paid, or on a payment plan. Some of the residents are holding out waiting to see action begin. The \$8616.35 is the tap in fee for 2005. Tony indicates this is a mile and a half of sewer installation. During construction, we will maintain the roadways as best as possible, but with the depth of 17' it may be necessary to close and detour some streets. Kenmore Construction won the bid and we hope to begin in July 2005 with completion in October/November 2006.

Mr. Potts questions the work around Oakwood/Sixth Street and many men are marking/painting the streets, what type of work is going to be done? Tony indicates this is for the storm water management project.
