New Ordinances & Resolutions

Temp. Ord. A-110 (Public Affairs)

A resolution expressing support for and urging passage of Issue 71, the Woodridge Local School District Tax Levy, at the General Election to be held on November 6, 2012, and declaring an emergency.

Public Hearing

Temp. Ord. A-85

An ordinance re-zoning Parcel No. 02-12047 (2307 23rd Street) from R-4 (“Urban Density Residential”) to MU-4 (“Sub-Urban Corridor”), authorizing a corresponding amendment of the City’s Official Zone Maps, and declaring an emergency.

An ordinance approving a conditional zoning certificate for the operation of a vehicle repair facility and outdoor sales lot at 1559 State Road, in an MU-4 Mixed Use District, and declaring an emergency.

An ordinance assigning and/or re-assigning the various job classifications of the City to appropriate established pay grades, and declaring an emergency.

A resolution accepting the amounts and rates of taxation as certified by the Summit County Budget Commission, authorizing the necessary tax levies, certifying such authorization to the County Fiscal Officer, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. A-104

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into a contract or contracts without competitive bidding with Wichert Insurance Services, Inc. for the professional services necessary to manage the City's risk management and insurance program and for the purchase of public entity insurance coverages, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. A-105

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract and/or contracts without competitive bidding with Karvo Paving Company for emergency pavement repairs to a portion of Graham Road, and declaring an emergency.

Public & Industrial Improvements:**Temp. Ord. A-107**

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for construction of a 4,397 square foot warehouse addition to a City-owned building at 2550 Bailey Road, and declaring an emergency.

Sub. Temp. Ord. A-108 (dated 10/15/12)

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the Improvement of State Road between Graham and Quick Roads, authorizing the Director of Finance to pay the City's estimated share of the costs therefor, and declaring an emergency.

An ordinance amending the Traffic Control File by providing for installation of various traffic control devices, and declaring an emergency.
